# **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

These agility trials are open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs of a registerable breed with an acceptable foreign registration number are eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Sec. 1 of the Dog Show Rules. Mixed breeds, breeds not registerable with the AKC, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate.

# **COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

# AWARDS

Rosettes and a toy valued at no more than \$3.00 will be awarded to the first through fourth place dogs in each jump height and each class. Novice STD – JWW – FAST – Division A is for dogs and persons that have never acquired any AKC agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-owner, or a member of the Owner's household. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility Title, or the Novice Jumpers With Weaves title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC agility title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the Owner, Co-owner, or household member subject to restrictions above.

<u>Open STD – JWW – FAST</u> – Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice & Open titles but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Excellent titles.

<u>Excellent A STD – JWW – FAST</u> – Open to dogs that have acquired the Open & Excellent titles, but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master titles.

<u>Excellent B STD – JWW – FAST</u> – Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent titles and dogs that have acquired the Master Excellent titles.

## PREFERRED CLASSES:

Preferred classes are offered at all levels. All dogs must start in the Novice Preferred Class regardless of AKC agility titles already earned.
